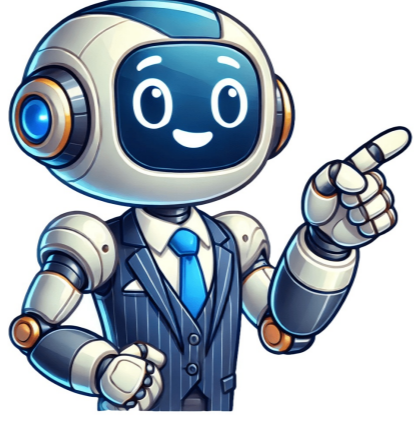

During vs For The difference between during and for is that during refers to 'when' something happens and for refers to 'how long' something happens. Compare: Every day I run for one hour. (=How long do you run?) I usually run during the weekend. (=When do you run?) During vs While The main difference between during and while is that we use while + clause (subject + verb), and we use during + noun. Compare: I fell asleep during the film.
