Horizon science academy lorain

Horizon Science Academy of Lorain South, 2140 E. 36th St., announced it will open for the fall 2025 school year. The new satellite elementary school will accept 150 students in August, according to officials from Horizon Science Academy of Lorain South. "It will have the same curriculum and same standards that Horizon has offered to the community throughout the community," said Jessika Varner, community engagement coordinator for Horizon Science Academy of Lorain, which has a campus at 760 Tower Blvd. in Lorain. "The only difference is we are going to be able to offer more availability to the south side of town, so we will have buildings covering all of Lorain." Kindergarten through second-grade students will attend the new facility. The school's master plan is to gradually expand and eventually accept students through the fifth grade, officials said. Horizon Science Academy of Lorain Assistant Principal Selahaddin Arifoglu said the school needed to expand to accommodate more students. "That's another reason why we're opening the school." Varner said the building previously was owned and operated by Summit Academy. Horizon officials bought the building in February 2024. Renovations to the building, including to 15 new classrooms, began at the beginning of 2025. "The first phase is painting the hallways and classrooms, changing the carpet and buying new furniture," Arifoglu said. Horizon Science Academy of Lorain Principal Sevket Simsek said the students also will have access to technology like smart boards, Chromebooks and one-on-one technology. Horizon Science Academy of Lorain South is set to open for a new school year in August 2025. The new facility will accept K-2 students. Principal Sevket Simsek and Assistant Principal Selahaddin Arifoglu are looking forward to serving South Lorain. (Clara Wicinski — The Morning Journal) Simsek said he is looking forward to serving the South Lorain community. "We had a big demand from our community and we said, 'Why not?'" he said. Simsek said the hiring process for teachers and staff is underway. Horizon Science Academy Lorain South is accepting enrollment for the fall 2025.
