Tank top A sleeveless shirt with wide or thin shoulder straps, commonly worn in summer or during exercise. Sweater A warm knitted top with long sleeves, worn in cold weather over a shirt or T-shirt. Hoodie A sweatshirt with a hood at the back, often used for casual wear or to stay warm outdoors. Jacket A short outerwear garment with sleeves, worn over other clothes to keep warm or stylish. Leggings Tight-fitting stretch pants that cover the legs fully and are often worn for comfort or exercise. Shorts Short pants that only cover part of the legs, worn in hot weather or during sports. Overalls A one-piece clothing item with trousers and a front chest panel, held up by shoulder straps; often worn for work. Jumpsuit A one-piece outfit combining a top and pants, worn for style or convenience, by both men and women. Tunic A long, loose top that usually covers the hips, often worn with leggings or pants. Sarong A large fabric piece wrapped around the waist, often worn at the beach or in tropical areas. Kimono A traditional Japanese robe with wide sleeves and a belt, now also worn as a modern outer garment. Parka A heavy, hooded jacket made for cold weather, often lined with fur or insulation.
