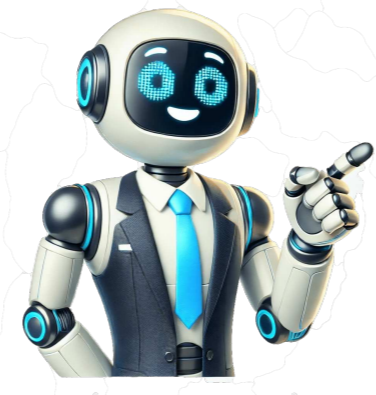

There are five levels of difficulty, ranging from beginner to expert. How do I play this scrabble online? Scrabble online can be played with the mouse. The game starts automatically, you have to make the first move, or you can "pass" to skip. Use the seven letters available under the game board to create valid words found in the Collins dictionary. Drag each letter corresponding to the proposed word and place them on the board making connections between the other words. Each word is validated and scored accordingly. What is allowed in the game of Scrabble? 1. Word Legality Words must be in the official Scrabble dictionary. Proper nouns, abbreviations, and hyphenated words are not allowed. Foreign words are allowed only if they are commonly used in English. 2. Tile Placement Rules Words must be placed horizontally or vertically. The first word must cover the center star tile. New words must connect to existing words on the board. 3. Scoring Rules Each letter has a point value. Premium squares (double/triple letter/word score) boost points. Playing all 7 tiles in one turn earns a 50-point bonus. 4. Challenge Rules Players can challenge words they believe are invalid. If the word is invalid, the player loses their turn. If the word is valid, the challenger loses their turn. 5. Tile Exchange & Passing Players can exchange tiles instead of playing a word but must skip their turn. Players can pass their turn if no valid move is available. 6. Ending the Game The game ends when a player uses all their tiles and no tiles remain in the bag. The game ends if no valid moves are left. If three consecutive turns are passed, the game ends.
