Here are the details: 1 Check out if your TV has a USB port - some smart TVs do, and this might work for you, 2 Plug in any old keyboard or mouse with a USB plug and see if it works as an input device. 3 Head to your TV settings and connect to Wi-Fi - hopefully, typing in your password will do the trick. If none of those methods work, try changing your Wi-Fi name and password on your router to match what's on your old network. Then, check to see if your TV connects automatically. Another option is to use your mobile hotspot - just rename it to the same name as your old network and connect to that. Finally, you can also use an ethernet cable and download your TV's associated app - this might take a bit more research to figure out which one works with your model. Use the Roku app on your smartphone to control your device and connect it to Wi-Fi without a physical remote. Open the app, tap on Remote, and ensure the remote is connected to the correct Roku device. You should see the name of the Roku at the top with a green dot indicating connection. Tap on the Home icon, then navigate to Settings > Network > Set up connection using the directional arrow pad. Follow the on-screen instructions to set up your Wi-Fi connection. If you're having trouble connecting wirelessly, consider using a wired connection if your device supports it. If your Roku gadget has an Ethernet cable slot, check if it's at the back of the unit for a marked port. If you have one, use an Ethernet link and plug it into your router. The Roku Streambar can also be connected to the router using a USB Ethernet adapter. Some Roku TVs might have an Ethernet slot as well, so verify the rear of the TV if yours has one. After connecting your Roku device to the router, follow these steps: Go to the Home display on your Roku and navigate to Settings > Network > Set up connection. Choose Wired link. Your Roku should automatically find your network. If your Roku keeps disconnecting from Wi-Fi, it might be due to DHCP being disabled on your router or a weak signal strength. Check if DHCP is turned on in the router settings; if not, enable it. If that doesn't resolve the issue, restart your Roku TV and see if the problem persists. A weak Wi-Fi signal could be the cause as well, so consider getting a Wi-Fi extender. To pair your Roku remote, identify which type you have: IR, Point Anywhere Standard, or Enhanced Remote. For an IR remote, just put in the batteries - no pairing is required. Other remotes require inserting batteries and waiting for the device to detect them automatically. If you need to reset your remote, take out the batteries from both the remote and the Roku itself. Reinsert the remote's batteries once the device turns back on, press and hold the pairing button for 3-5 seconds, then wait a minute or so - the remote should now be re-paired. 1. Using a Roku Mobile App for Easy Connection To access your Roku content on a mobile device, first ensure that you are connected to the same Wi-Fi network that is connected to your Roku TV. The Roku app allows seamless streaming from your mobile device without needing a physical remote. Alternatively, if your remote is lost or not working, using an Ethernet connection can be an effective solution. Connect one end of the Ethernet cable to the back of your Roku TV and the other end to your router's available port. Wait for the device to automatically detect the connection, then navigate to the settings menu and select "Network" followed by "Wired" or "Ethernet." Another option is using a universal remote compatible with Roku devices. Check the compatibility first and refer to the manual instructions to enter the setup process. This will allow you to connect your Roku TV to Wi-Fi directly from your mobile device or via a universal remote, ensuring uninterrupted streaming of your favorite content. To connect to Wi-Fi, follow these steps using a universal remote: Use the directional buttons to navigate and select characters when prompted for network name (SSID) and password on the TV screen. Ensure it's programmed correctly during setup. 1. Go to your Roku TV settings menu after pressing the WPS button on your router. 2. Select Wi-Fi Protected Setup or Wi-Fi setup option from the available options. 3. Your Roku TV will automatically detect nearby Wi-Fi networks and try to connect. 4. Wait a few seconds for connection establishment, you'll receive confirmation message. Alternatively, use Roku mobile app to connect to Wi-Fi, download the app and set it up on your mobile device and follow the in-app instructions to access your streaming features without needing remote control. Or use Universal Remote with WPS to navigate setup menu and connect to Wi-Fi, follow the given instructions from the remote. HDMI-CEC allows you to stream content using your remote control of other devices connected via HDMI. To control your Roku without a remote, you can use the mobile app or browser extension as a virtual remote. To do this, both your Roku and other device need to be on the same network, with your Roku connected to a Wi-Fi connection. If your Roku is already connected to a Wi-Fi network, you can switch it over to another one using the mobile app or desktop browser extension. However, if your Roku isn't connected to Wi-Fi at all, this method won't work. To use the Roku mobile app as a virtual remote: 1. Set up the Roku app on your phone and connect it to the same Wi-Fi network as the Roku player. 2. Open the Roku app and tap Devices in the bottom-right corner of the screen. 3. Tap your Roku device when it appears in the app, then select Connect to let your phone be connected to the Roku as a remote. 4. Use the virtual remote to select Settings on the left side of the Roku's home screen, then select Network and follow the prompts to set up connection. Alternatively, you can use the browser extension for Microsoft Edge or Google Chrome. 1. Download the desired browser extension and connect your computer and Roku player to the same Wi-Fi network. 2. Open the browser extension and click on Devices in the top-right corner of the screen. 3. Select your Roku device from the list, then select Connect to let the browser extension control your Roku as a remote. Note that you'll need to be connected to Wi-Fi already for this method to work. 1. Open Google Chrome on your computer and click on the Remoku icon in the top right toolbar to activate a virtual remote. 2. Using the virtual remote, select Settings > Network, then Set up connection > Wireless to connect your Roku device to Wi-Fi. 3. If you've selected a different Wi-Fi network, reconnect your computer and try using the virtual remote again. 4. Alternatively, use an Ethernet cable to connect your Roku device to the router and have your iPhone or Android connected wirelessly on the same network. Open the Roku app, select Devices, tap your Roku device, then Remote. 5. Use the virtual remote to set up a wired connection by selecting Settings > Network, then Set up connection > Wired, enter your password, and Connect.
