In broad terms, the Great Place To Work Trust Index™ Survey measures the level of trust in your organization and the consistency of the employee experience. In other words: How often can employees count on something happening in their workplace, such as clear and honest leadership, fair treatment, and employee recognition?More specifically, the Great Place To Work Trust Index Survey measures individual employee experiences of five dimensions of a high-trust company culture through 60 statements and two open-ended questions. Three of the dimensions are connected to the actions of leaders and building trust: credibility, respect, and fairness. The other two dimensions measure the workplace experience of employees in relation to their colleagues and the wider organization: pride and a sense of belonging. These five dimensions create a workplace culture where employees feel empowered and encouraged to do their most meaningful work. High-trust cultures are shown in Great Place To Work research to outperform their competitors in recruitment and retention, productivity and innovation, and financial performance. Survey answers are assessed on a five-point scale, revealing the most common experience of employees in the organization. Employee scores are averaged to provide an organization-wide assessment of workplace culture: the Trust Index score. We recognize the importance of financial and planning for the future, which is why we offer a 401(k) package with a generous employer match. Because the Academy Group is committed to the health and wellness of its team members, our employees receive a comprehensive health plan, vacation time, and wellness days. No. Beginning in September, 2024, we have updated our sibling preference policy to ensure that our process is equitable to all interested families. We created a unique funding model that continuously nurtures and supports our pipeline of exceptional human capital. Launched from initial investments by Mark and Kimbra Walter, we built a model where we invest in a diverse portfolio of commercial companies that share our vision. Then, we use the revenue to support The Academy's operations. We established ownership stakes in our portfolio companies, CFI Partners and Cleveland Avenue, which return a portion of net income to fund our program. This innovative structure ensures opportunities for members while leading to a model that will eventually be self-sustaining without the need for philanthropic capital. In addition to the Opportunity Scholarship, all members are offered up to \$25k, amortized over 4 years, for college persistence. This stipend can be used to offset fees associated with college attendance, including but not limited to housing, books, and food. From 4th grade through employment, our core program offers a journey that guides members through an interdisciplinary exploration of colleges, careers, and wealth building. We reinforce core skills that accelerate academic progress and put members on track to achieve success. Through rigorous, hands-on exploration of economics, entrepreneurship, design thinking, and justice, the Academy Group helps young people acquire the skills and mindsets to lead, own and create opportunities for their families and communities.
