Oak hill consignment sale 2024 schedule

Our successful event relies on the dedication of numerous volunteers! All volunteer shifts last three hours and are a fantastic opportunity to have fun while being fueled by food and drinks. If you're consigning with us, please schedule your drop off at least 30 minutes before or after your shift. Children aren't permitted during volunteer shifts. To sign up for a shift, scroll down to the bottom of this page and click on "Click Here To Sign Up For A Shift". Registered Consignors can find their volunteer opportunities by logging in to their My Sale Manager account. As a token of appreciation, volunteers get exclusive access to our pre-sales! VIP Night takes place on Tuesday from 5 pm - 8 pm for any volunteer who works two shifts and consignors who work one shift. The Consignor/Volunteer Pre-Sale is available on Wednesday from 8 am - 10 am, open to all consignors and volunteers, with each consignor allowed to add one friend to the Buddy Pass list. On Friday, we have a Half Price Pre-Sale for our consignors and volunteers. Important notes: All items marked "REDUCE" on the tag will be sold at 50% off. Children under 12 are not permitted at any of these pre-sales, except infants who can be carried in a carrier. HEAVY LIFTING SHIFTS are available during drop-off days to help with unloading and placing large items on the sales floor. Those who complete this shift will receive a VIP Sale shopping pass. Email us for more information. The RE-SORT SHIFT is another crucial role, taking place on Saturday from 11 am - 2 pm. Any volunteer completing this shift will be added to our list to shop at the VIP Pre-Sale during our next event. Welcome back or new consignors! To register, head to our homepage and enter your consignor number and password if you're a returning vendor. For newcomers, click the button for "Need a Consignor Number" to sign up as a fresh face. You'll be prompted to pay a \$25 non-refundable fee online through PayPal, which you can do with either your account, credit card, or debit card. After completing payment, make sure to hit the RETURN TO MERCHANT link at the bottom of the receipt page to get back to our website and finish signing up. Don't forget to schedule a drop-off appointment and review volunteer shifts - we couldn't run this sale without our volunteers! For detailed step-by-step instructions on registering as a new consignor, click here. Once you're all registered, you can log in to My Sale Manager by clicking this link. In there, you can view and adjust your drop-off schedule, book your volunteer shifts, add inventory, and print tags. You'll also be able to check reports during the sale for your sold items and generate a Seller Report afterwards that shows your item sales percentage with detailed info. Plus, you can run a Donation Report to see what's been donated and use it for tax purposes. Take a minute to review our accepted items list so tagging and checkout go smoothly. Click here to see what we accept and what we don't. We've got some guidelines to follow: * The minimum number of items per consignor is 12, with up to 300 allowed. * Each item should be priced at least \$4.00. * Inventory can be entered until 2pm on the Tuesday before the sale. * Tags must be printed on standard white cardstock and attached to clothing with a safety pin. Clothes should be hung on wire hangers with a numeric size label - for example, if an item is listed as Medium (8/10), enter '8' as the size. When it comes to pricing, remember that it's subjective, so aim to price items at 1/3 of their original retail price and adjust based on brand and condition. For retailers like Hanna Andersson, J.Crew, and Gap, consider the discounted prices when setting your prices. Make sure everything is clean and properly tagged - we want those items to sell! And don't forget to mark items as "REDUCE" so they can go for 50% off during the half-price sale. Drop off appointments can be scheduled from the Consignor My Sale Manager Homepage link above. Upon arrival, items must be placed on a designated rack. Learn more about the two drop-off options below. The 2025 Spring/Summer Sale schedule is as follows: - Drop-off: Monday (12 pm - 5 pm), Tuesday (8 am - 2 pm) - VIP Pre-sale: Tuesday (5 pm - 8 pm) for Consignors working one shift and Volunteers working two shifts. No children under 12 are allowed. - Consignor/Volunteer Pre-sale: Wednesday (8 am - 10 am). Only consignors, volunteers, and buddy pass holders can participate. No children under 12 are permitted. - Public Sale: Wednesday to Thursday (10 am - 5 pm) - Half Price Pre-sale: Friday morning for consignors and volunteers only. Items marked as "REDUCE" will be sold at 50% of their listed price. No children under 12 are allowed, but infants can accompany parents if worn in carriers. - Public Half Price Sale: Friday afternoon to Saturday morning. Consignor pickup is scheduled for Saturday from 2 pm - 3 pm. All items not picked up will be donated at 3 pm. The sale offers a variety of products including baby, toddler, children's, teen, maternity, and adult clothing and accessories for women and men. Strollers are allowed throughout the event. Restrooms are available. Pre-sales offer discounts to consignors and volunteers, but no children under 12 can attend these events. Payment is accepted in various forms, including cash, debit cards, and credit cards. The sale is a fundraiser for Blessings in the Horizon, a nonprofit organization that supports cancer patients during their treatment. Various Childrens Consignment Sales in Nashville area happening bi-annually or seasonally featuring quality infant and kids clothing, accessories, toys, etc with sellers getting 70-80% profit share after working a shift. Proceeds often support local needy families via parish ministries. Specific dates, hours & conditions vary but generally include charity presales, consignor pre-sales, public sales & half-price days with discounted prices on final day. Sales locations include church fellowship halls, preschool grounds & private homes within Nashville city limits. For the most up-to-date information, visit our website or email us with questions. Our Fall/Winter sale includes infants', boys', girls', juniors' and large boys' 16-20 clothing items such as all-season dress code/uniforms, jeans, khakis pants, heavy/lightweight jackets, Halloween costumes, T-shirts. Our Spring/Summer sale features similar items, but please note that we do not accept winter apparel. We also consider light long sleeves with a holiday theme for the Spring Sale and accept certain types of pants. We accept a wide range of children's items including all-season maternity clothing (limited to 20 items per consignor), shoes, cribs, swings, bedroom furniture, strollers, car seats, infant equipment, toys, books, games, room decor, bedding, backpacks, purses, accessories, sporting goods, dance/gymnastic wear, bicycles, scooters, and riding toys. In good condition, we also accept brand-name stuffed animals like TY Beanie Babies, Build-a-Bear, and Disney. However, please ensure they are stain-free, tear-free, smell-free, and animal-hair-free. Our sales take place at the Nashville Fairgrounds-Expo 2, located at 500 Wedgewood Ave, Nashville, TN 37203. Phone: (615) 707-7541, Email: yolandaprince@jbsale.com. Public admission is \$3 or free with a ticket from our website. The sale typically takes place over two days in the Spring and Fall, with different hours for each day. On October 6th for Helpers, Consignors, Special Community Groups, and Paid Tiered Early Access Tickets, the Wednesday Presale begins. Children under two years old are permitted, but only if they're in a stroller or carrier; wagons are also allowed. The Oak Hill School Enrichment Center, located at 4815 Franklin Road, Nashville, TN 37220 (email: consignment_sale@oakhillschool.org), will host the event. For spring and fall sales, check their website for dates, hours, and conditions. Accepted items include: * Children's clothing sizes newborn to size 16 * Fall/Winter clothing, such as Halloween costumes and coats * Spring/Summer clothing, including bathing suits and swim accessories * Shoes in excellent condition with clean soles * Toys that are clean, fully working, and have all original pieces and batteries * Baby and children's furniture that's fully assembled * Books (children's books only) * Home decor items like artwork, lamps, and seasonal-specific items Note: The maximum number of inventory items accepted is 300, with a minimum value of \$4.00 per item. Jewelry and clothing not suitable for the current season will not be accepted. Spring/Summer sale does not include Halloween costumes, Thanksgiving or Christmas outfits. Fall/Winter sale excludes t-shirts, shorts, bathing suits, sandals, underwear, and socks (except athletic wear). Monograms with three letters like "AMS" are okay, but those longer than that won't be accepted. School uniforms and apparel with specific logos will also be rejected. Shoes and clothes showing significant wear (stained, ripped, or pilled) will not be considered. Clothing in bags must be hung on wire hangers. Outdated clothing is also not allowed. Furniture: Only baby/children's furniture will be accepted. Toys, books, and media: Stuffed animals with broken or missing parts, unclean toys, VHS tapes, movies rated PG-13 or above, video games with a Teen (T), Mature (M) or Adult Only (AO) rating, and single paperback books are not allowed. Dolly Parton Imagination Library Books are the only exception. Infant items: Baby bottles, sippy cups, plates, utensils, nipples or pacifiers without original packaging, baby blankets, burp cloths, and bibs without packaging will not be accepted. Breast pumps without packaging, Bumbo seats without safety belts, car seats with less than a year before expiration, cloth diapers or covers, changing pads or covers without packaging, crib bedding, bumpers or mobiles without packaging, and diaper pails without packaging are also rejected. Home/Decor: Kitchen appliances, electronics, exercise equipment, kitchen items, lawn equipment, linens, and mattresses (including crib mattresses) will not be accepted unless they are new in the box. Pet-related items: Beds, cages/crates/tanks, feeding rugs, and seasonal decor will only be accepted if they are suitable for the upcoming season. For Consignors, a non-refundable registration fee of \$25 will be paid through PayPal during sign-up. Failure to complete registration may require manual enrollment by emailing the same address. If you're registered but not showing as such, ensure you clicked "return to merchant" after paying your fee or reach out to consignment_sale@oakhillschool.org for assistance. Consignor numbers can be requested upon registration; if available, they'll be assigned. Be aware that items left uncollected on Saturday at 3 pm will be donated without exception. To collect your unsold items, we'll have them sorted except for large or fragile ones. Make sure to inspect your items before leaving. Any leftover items will be collected by charities after the sale. If you forgot a laundry hamper or storage bin, your unsold items might be donated and not available for later pickup. Missing item tags can sometimes occur; we try to locate them but won't compensate for thefts. Payment for consignors is issued in checks mailed 2-3 weeks prior to the sale. Ensure your address is up-to-date on your Consignor Homepage, as this is where your check will be sent. For tagging instructions and supplies, see our Google Drive link or Amazon for recommended cardstock and accessories. Can I find cardstock, hangers and safety pins easily? Yes, you can find these items at any office supply store, Walmart or Target. Which color ink should I use for tagging? We only accept black ink. Can I use a tagging gun? No, tags attached by a tagging gun often get separated and can also leave marks/holes in the clothes. Do I need to print a new tag if I change the description, size, price or donation status of an item? Yes, you must print a new tag. The barcode contains the information that was entered into the computer at the time it was printed. If you make a change online, you must print a new tag to reflect the new information. Can I use the same tag if an item did not sell at a previous Oak Hill sale? Yes, as long as you are not updating any of the information. You will need to add the item to your active inventory in order to sell it at the current sale. Do I have to use the same tags from other consignment sales? No, you may not use tags from other consignment sales. The tags are specific to Oak Hill and need to be placed in your Active Inventory for the current Oak Hill sale. What if a tag is missing from an item? We can look up inventory on our software. If you have entered a good description, we can usually find the item and print a new tag. Can I bring my children to any of the Pre-Sales or during my volunteer shift? No children under 12 years old can attend any Pre-Sales. Infants worn in a carrier are allowed. No children are allowed during your volunteer shift. When can I pick up large items purchased during the sale? During our sale hours, you may pick up large items purchased. All items must be picked up by 11 am on Saturday. What is the return policy? All sales are final. Please inspect items prior to purchasing. Is everything 50% off during the half price sale? No, only items with "REDUCE" will sell at 50% of the listed price. The choice to reduce an item Items typically account for 70% of our sale, marked as sold at reduced prices. Q: What happens if I left storage bins after drop off and all my items were sold? A: You must pick up your bin between 2 pm - 3 pm on Saturday; otherwise, it will be donated.
